2) Minutes of previous meeting

3) Secretary's Report

<u>Juniors</u>

Continuing growth in the junior numbers has prompted Kenny Martin to offer members the opportunity to take part in coaching.

- Course fees will be paid by Kenny

7) Maintenance - Supervisors Report

Gas supply issue still to be resolved, currently in dispute with British Gas (BG) about responsibility for making the supply compliant. We've now been made aware that the supply to the meter is insufficient, however as this was installed by BG and has been inspected year on year (since installation) by BG we're struggling to understand how this is our problem.

Courts are coming up to 3.5 years since their refurb are due for a clean, not that you'd know - thanks to the fantastic job Mike Archibald is doing keeping them in good condition. Due to other necessary works it's proposed that cleaning be postponed to 2019 (actual date to be confirmed).

It has been noted that since removal of the plastic cups juniors are drinking water from the taps in the toilets - the water in the toilet taps is not drinking water and as such they could be at risk. The committee find this unacceptable and are going to temporarily reinstate drinking cups until the water supply can be altered to remove the possibility of contamination.



8) Ongoing Maintenance Programme

While it's currently working, we've been informed that our boiler is now unrepairable. With the prospect of winter approaching the committee have made it a priority to replace it. Boiler replacement and associated works to cost £2500 (incl. VAT) - the new boiler comes with a 10yr guarantee

It's been many years since the court heaters were overhauled - £400 (incl. VAT)

Water supply to be converted to direct supply, this will remove the cold water tank from the roof-space and remove the possibility of Legionella. £2200 (incl. VAT)

Thanks to Richard Brown and Mike Archibald for putting together the schedule for the work and engaging with the contractors
